In brief, the board also discussed some of the issues we will address during the coming year. They are as follows and have not been prioritized:

- 1) Survey of dredging for the boat ramp
- 2) Security issues, including alleged climbing of the brick wall into the neighborhood
- 3) Preventative maintenance of both the exterior and interior portions of the brick walls that surround the neighborhood
- 4) Cleaning the exterior walls and sidewalks of the mold that continues to build around the walls and entrance areas
- 5) Assistance from Orange County on repairing some of the lighting in the neighborhood that is either not working properly, or installed incorrectly.
- 6) Investigating and evaluating all projected and anticipated costs in the 2008 budget.
- 7) Implementation of a higher level web server/forum in order to

more efficiently address issues of concern to all of our residents.

- 8) Establishment of additional committees (yet to be determined) to create more collaboration and involvement from our residents.
- 9) One such committee suggested was "Event Planning." We'd like to encourage more social events so that we learn more about each other and our families.

Finally, the board is requesting inputs from everyone regarding any issue you'd like to see addressed during the coming year. We'd also like to publish everyone's email address and background/professions so that we can better communicate between ourselves.

We all come from different walks of life and I am certain we all have things to share that can make our neighborhood a fun place to live.

For the time being, the next board meeting will be scheduled in March sometime, but we decided to make it contingent upon your responses to any issues you'd like to see addressed and also any ideas for new committees that would make Conway Place a fun place to live.
